









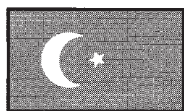




Flag Fun!

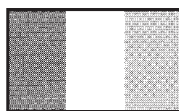

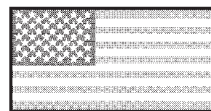

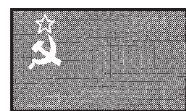
